Not unusual to see a row of Harleys lined up out front, but the place is actually quite welcoming to the lawyers, teachers and corporate types who also stop in. Set back from the highway, it looks like your classic roadhouse, and its neon lighting makes quite a sight at night. Sit outside in the summer and enjoy the sweet sounds of roaring motorcycles. The kind of place that usually has a dog running around the bar, and inevitably a biker with a harmonica will start playing. Blues bands play on Thursday and Friday nights in very close proximity to the patrons. Ten-inch bar pies are \$5 and premium drafts (Newcastle, Blue Moon) are about \$4. Laid back but rockin,' it gets packed around midnight.
